<p>d)There shall be one Deputy General Secretary, One Asst General Secretary and two EC members where the number of EC members in a zone exceeds 250.</p>	<p>d) There shall be one Deputy General Secretary, two Asst General Secretaries and four EC members where the number of members in a Region exceeds 400. One additional EC for every 50 members over and above 400 members, however the number of EC members in a Region should not exceed Six (6).</p>
<p>Executive Committee Meetings: The Executive Committee of the association shall meet atleast once in three months for carrying on the business of the association or as frequently as necessary.</p>	<p>The Executive Committee of the association shall meet at least two times in a periodicity of one calendar year. Out of which, one meeting can be Virtual and the other shall be Physical meeting for carrying on the business of the association or as frequently as necessary.</p>
	<p>Regional Committee: Every region may form Regional Committee consisting of one (1) Regional Secretary, one (1) Treasurer and up to maximum of five (5) members. Regional Secretary and Treasurer shall be from the elected EC members of the respective region.</p>
	<p>Enabling Clause: Any clauses or regulations or terms of Bye-laws/Constitutions relating to functioning and management of our Retirees Association, which are not incorporated in our Bye-laws or Articles of Associations, may be adopted from the records of AIBRF, to which we are affiliated, with a specific resolution by EC, whenever required or occasion arises.</p> <p>Any electronic communication made such as WhatsApp, Telegram, Instagram or Twitter etc., used by the authorized signatories of the association shall be treated as official communication except statutory notices.</p>
	<p>Authorized Executive Committee to spare / contribute / donate funds to any Trust or Society formed for the specific purpose of welfare of erstwhile Andhra Bank Retired employees or their Kith & Kin out of Corpus/funds/subscriptions.</p>
