There could not have been better conclusion of the current action program than on last day meeting the Honorable President of India and submitting memorandum to her on Updation.

Main Highlights of Action Programs conducted during the month of May, 2023 are as under

- (a) Submissions of memorandum to 547 Members of Parliament from Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha by all State Committees
- (b) In addition to the submission of memorandum to Members of Parliament, State Committees like Telangana, North West (consisting of Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and J&K), Odisha, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala, Utter Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, North East, Eastern Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh met 29 MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT in delegation and submitted the memorandum on Updation. All these members of extended full support on the demand of Updation. Some of them have also assured to raise the issue of Updation in the next session of the parliament.
- (c) 12 Members of Parliament including senior Central Minster Shri Nitin Gadkari have forwarded AIBRF Memorandum on Updation to the Finance Minister recommending early action on the demand.
- 7. We convey our sincere thanks to the leadership of State Committees and affiliates for taking effective and prompt steps in ensuring successful implementation of action program. Next round of action program on Updation will be announced soon.
